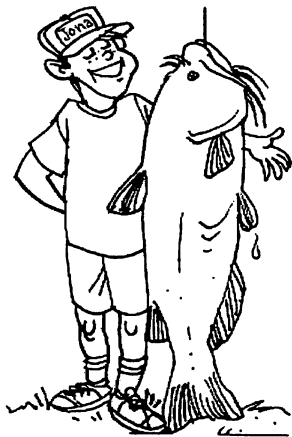


FISHING GUIDELINES

Because Nazareth serves as a home for so many people and businesses, it is necessary to establish regulations which will benefit everyone concerned.

PARKING - Security Post parking lot, SCN Center and the area behind the Mechanic Shop.

Parking on the grass, including all the areas around the lakes and along the sides of the roads is not permitted.

Shirts must be worn at all times on Nazareth premises.

CHILDREN under 16 years of age may accompany the parent or another adult and fish without charge. Children must have adult supervision at all times.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are not permitted on Nazareth property.

The carrying of deadly weapons on the Nazareth property are prohibited.

Please help us to keep our lakes in good ecological balance by observing the fishing guidelines listed on the back:

The Nazareth Lakes are open for fishing from March 1 until December 31 (each year) unless special circumstances require that they be closed the entire year.

Anyone wishing to fish must obtain a permit and have a valid Kentucky Fishing License. Both permits must be available when fishing at Nazareth.

PERMITS can be obtained at the Switchboard in O'Connell Hall from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday.

The permit is valid for the complete fishing season (March 1 - December 31).

The cost of the permit is \$10.00. The cost for persons age 65 or older is \$5.00. There is no charge for SCNs, SCNAs, Nazareth employees and Nazareth Village I and II residents.

The permit allows the holder to fish in three fishing lakes on Campus, SCN Center Lake, Roadside Lake, and Immaculate Conception Lake (please see the map on the inside for location of the lakes).

FISHING HOURS are from sunrise to sunset each day.

LIVE MINNOWS should not be used for bait nor dumped into the lakes. If allowed in the water, these odd species of fish are harmful to the eggs of the bass.

OTHER SPECIES OF FISH (crappie, other types of sunfish, etc.) should not be put into the lakes. The lakes have been scientifically stocked with the correct balance of species for optimum production of bass, bluegill, and catfish. The lakes have been stocked with Triploid grass carp to help control the growth of algae. If you catch one of these fish by mistake, please throw it back.

FISHING is permitted only from the banks. **BOATS/CANOES** or **WADING** into the water to fish is not permitted.

THE SIZE LIMIT for bass is 15 inches in length. **THE NUMBER OF BASS AND CATFISH** taken in one visit should not exceed five (5). There is no limit to the number of bluegill allowed.

Please help us keep the Nazareth grounds beautiful by **NOT LITTERING**.
